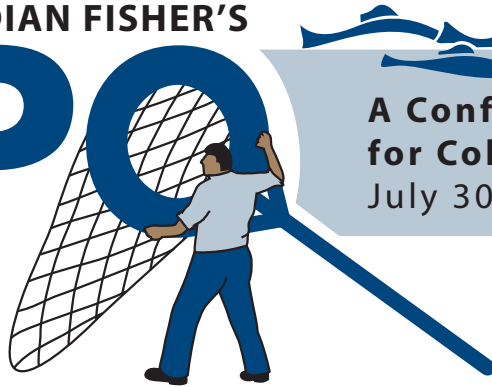

Be sure to clear your calendar for the upcoming Columbia River Indian Fisher's Expo in Hood River. The event will take place at the Hood River Inn, which is the hotel next to the bridge between Hood River and White Salmon. It runs from 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Friday, July 30 and from 8:30 a.m. to 3 p.m. on Saturday.

The full two-day schedule features a trade show with vendors demonstrating products geared for fishing on the Columbia River, the opportunity to meet with members of your tribe's Fish & Wildlife Committee, fifteen different classes and presentations, and an included breakfast and lunch. The event is free for all Yakama, Umatilla, Warm Springs, and Nez Perce fishers.

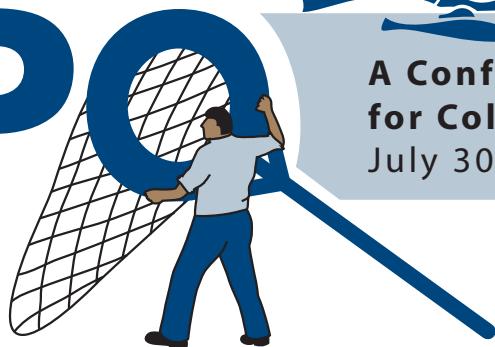

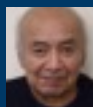
